# Change to Shut Down Dates Commencing 2024

For those of you who have been with the Chris Ruth Centre for a number of years you may recall we used to close twice during the year. 1 week at the end of July beginning of August and the other 3 weeks over the Christmas period (allowing staff to use their 4 weeks leave as per the employment act).

Following a staff consultation process (completed by Hello Monday - HR company) and with our Board approval, the result is that we are able to implement this into staff's employment agreement and will be doing so commencing 2024.

# What this means for all concerned is:

All centres will be closed as of **July 29<sup>th</sup> through to August 2<sup>nd</sup> - reopening on August 5<sup>th</sup>.** Closing in December (at a date to be determined) for 3 weeks plus the statutory holiday days. As an example, if we finished on Dec 20<sup>th</sup> 2024 it would be an approximate start back date of January 20<sup>th</sup> 2025.

This change not only allows the people we support to have a break and re energise but it also helps with staff fatigue and burn out.

A reminder about this information will be sent out again in our newsletters next year.



# **Property** Changes

Matters are progressing smoothly at this time for the additional building to be completed for our Kaiapoi site as mentioned in the last newsletter. We look forward to this being ready for use by the middle of next year.

Following many hours of consultation and preliminary work it has been decided that instead of redeveloping the existing two story portion of the Hoon Hay complex it has become clear that the viable option is to demolish this space along with the Hancock hall and build a modern facility brand new. There is an extreme amount of work required with this project and I would like to acknowledge all those involved in the Building committee for their contribution to date. Planning and development will be for an extended period of time. However the Board of Trustees has a vision and aspiration to make this happen. With the help, support and assistance of a number of people, we believe this will happen.

Please note that our current service and spaces will not be impacted and will continue to operate as there is enough square footage to accommodate both activities. We will keep you updated as the project progresses.
